We are looking for seasonal scenic views as well as wildlife pictures of the Stour Valley. We are looking for cheerful and colourful rather than moody and atmospheric. Ideally, the photos will be landscape and keep people to a minimum.

We will be accepting photos from 1st April 2021 until the 31st August 2021. There will be a limit of 5 pictures submitted per person. Staff at Kingfisher Barn will be judging the photos for the competition.

Winners will be featured in our next calendar and receive a free copy of the calendar. The photo with the most votes will also receive a £10 Hengistbury Head gift voucher.

COMPETITION RULES FOR THE 2022 CALENDAR:

1. The competition is free to enter and is open to all ages
2. The closing date is 31st August 2021
3. Entries must be emailed to stour.valley@bcpcouncil.gov.uk and please label it 'photography competition' in the subject of the e-mail
4. The file must be at least 1mb in size
5. Entries will not be accepted by post and any postal entries will not be entered or returned
6. Telephone or e-mail confirmation of receipt is not available
7. Each person can submit a maximum of 5 photo's
8. The judges' decision is final
9. The photographer retains copyright and will be credited if their photo is successful
10. Winners will be notified by 31st September 2021.
11. If people feature in your photograph (not recommended), you must obtain their written permission to use the photograph for the calendar, in accordance with GDPR (for more information visit the [Information Commissioner's Office website](#)).
